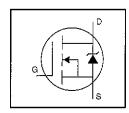
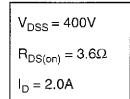

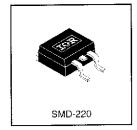




## Description

Third Generation HEXFETs from International Rectifier provide the designer with the best combination of fast switching, ruggedized device design, low on-resistance and cost-effectiveness.

The SMD-220 is a surface mount power package capable of accommodating die sizes up to HEX-4. It provides the highest power capability and the lowest possible on-resistance in any existing surface mount package. The SMD-220 is suitable for high current applications because of its low internal connection resistance and can dissipate up to 2.0W in a typical surface mount application.

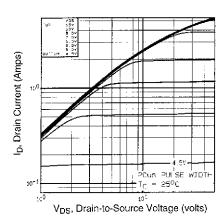
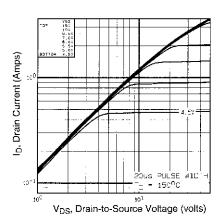


Fig 1. Typical Output Characteristics, Tc=25°C



**Fig 2.** Typical Output Characteristics, Tc=150°C

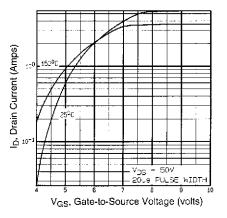


Fig 3. Typical Transfer Characteristics

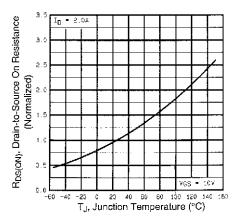
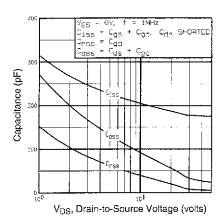


Fig 4. Normalized On-Resistance Vs. Temperature



**Fig 5.** Typical Capacitance Vs. Drain-to-Source Voltage

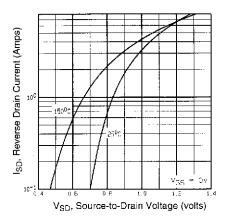


Fig 7. Typical Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage

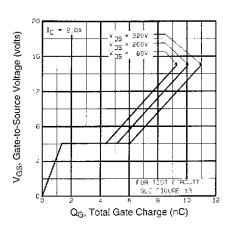


Fig 6. Typical Gate Charge Vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage

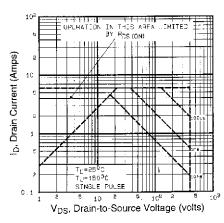


Fig 8. Maximum Safe Operating Area

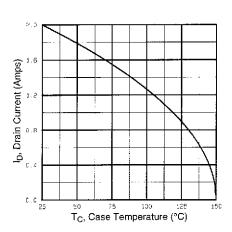


Fig 9. Maximum Drain Current Vs. Case Temperature

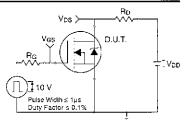


Fig 10a. Switching Time Test Circuit

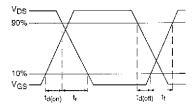


Fig 10b. Switching Time Waveforms

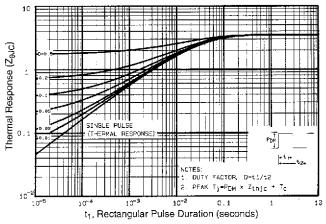


Fig 11. Maximum Effective Transient Thermal Impedance, Junction-to-Case

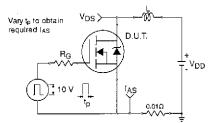


Fig 12a. Unclamped Inductive Test Circuit

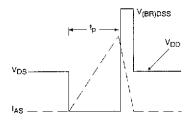


Fig 12b. Unclamped Inductive Waveforms

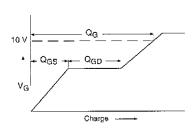


Fig 13a. Basic Gate Charge Waveform

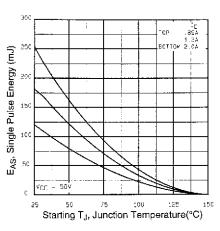


Fig 12c. Maximum Avalanche Energy Vs. Drain Current

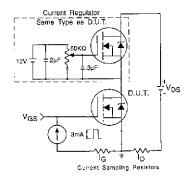


Fig 13b. Gate Charge Test Circuit
