30V N-Channel PowerTrench $^{\circ}$ MOSFET

General Description

This N-Channel MOSFET has been designed specifically to improve the overall efficiency of DC/DC converters using either synchronous or conventional switching PWM controllers. It has been optimized for low gate charge, low $R_{\text{DS}(\text{ON})}$, fast switching speed and extremely low $R_{\text{DS}(\text{ON})}$ in a small package.

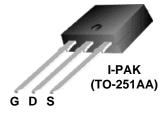

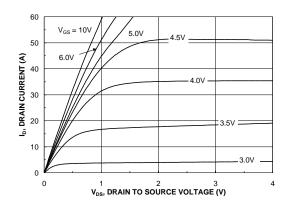


Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics

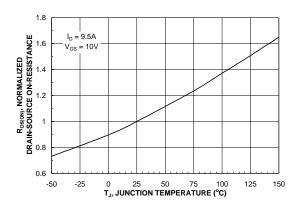


Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation withTemperature

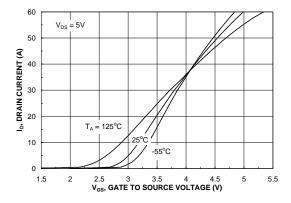


Figure 5. Transfer Characteristics

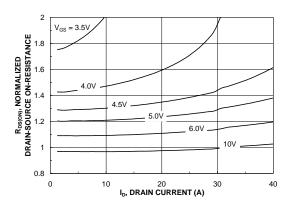


Figure 2. On-Resistance Variation with Drain Current and Gate Voltage

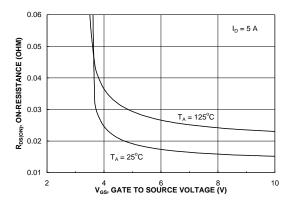


Figure 4. On-Resistance Variation with Gate-to-Source Voltage

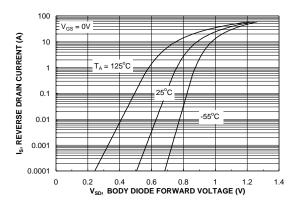
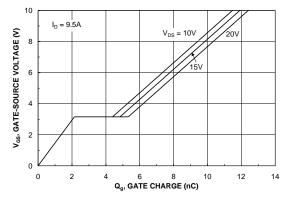


Figure 6. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation with Source Current and Temperature

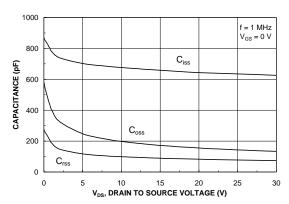
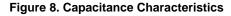
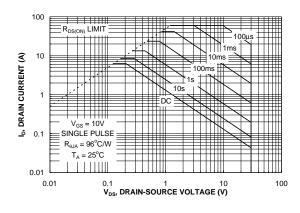


Figure 7. Gate Charge Characteristics





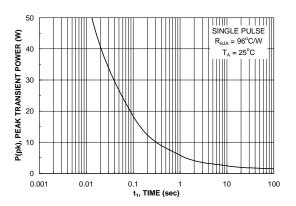


Figure 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area

Figure 10. Single Pulse Maximum Power Dissipation

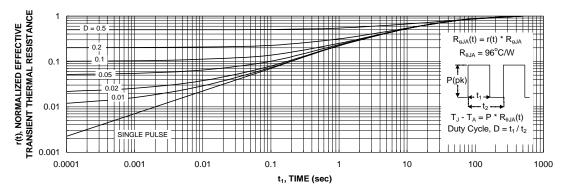


Figure 11. Transient Thermal Response Curve
